Linking Your Domain Name to Your Delta Media Group Web Site

To understand what Domain Name Service (DNS) is and how it is used, it is best to start with an example: Andy Agent wishes to register and setup his web site and link www.AndyAgent.com to his Delta Media site.



Register Your Domain

Andy goes to a provider such as (GoDaddy, MyDomain, NetworkSolutions, Register.com, etc) and searches to see if his name is available.

In this case he wants www.AndyAgent.com which is available. He purchases (but he's really paying a fee to use it for a period of time – 1 year, 2 years, etc.). Andy will remember his ID and PASSWORD keep it in a safe place.

Once registered Andy needs to tell his registrar (GoDaddy, MyDomain, NetworkSolutions, Register.com, etc) where his Delta Media Group website is. He can do this in **one of two (2) ways:**

1. FORWARDING – Andy can simply forward his new Domain name to his site by forwarding to www.CompanySite.com/aagent (this is his company's site and his user name). This is often used when Andy is also forwarding his email (andy@andyagent.com forwarding to andyagent@yahoo.com).

2. SET DNS (Domain Nameservers) for www.AndyAgent.com need to be set to:

NS1.DELTAGROUP.COM
NS2.DELTAGROUP.COM

Each registrar has their own tools to Forward or SET Domain Nameserver (DNS). If you have trouble – send a request for help to support@deltagroup.com and remember to provide your contact information, domain name and provider and the access information.

Considerations

Scenario 1: If the agent uses domain forwarding from his domain provider - no action needed to DMG.

Scenario 2: If the agent uses domain forwarding and email forwarding from his domain provider – no action needed to DMG.

Scenario 3: If the agent sets his nameservers at his domain provider to ns1.deltagroup and ns2.deltagroup.com and has no email associated – he needs to fill out the WEBSITE – DOMAIN function with the domain name he is using.

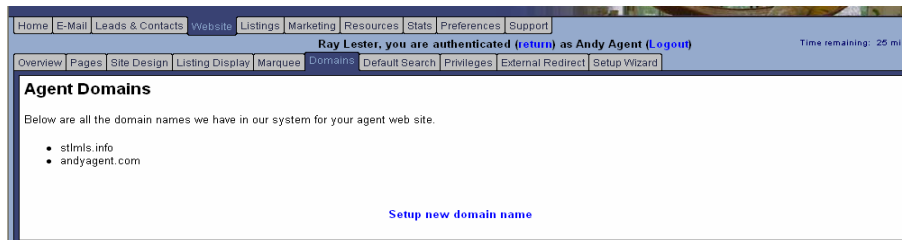
Scenario 4: If the agent sets his nameservers at his domain provider to ns1.deltagroup.com and ns2.deltagroup.com and his email is provided by a 3rd party (Verizon, AOL, Yahoo, etc.) and wants to use an email address name such as andy@andyagent.com - he needs to fill out the WEBSITE – DOMAIN function with the domain name – and contact support@deltagroup.com to subscribe to DMG email forwarding (additional cost).

Scenario 5: If the agent sets his nameservers at his domain provider to ns1.deltagroup.com and ns2.deltagroup.com and his email is hosted at his domain provider (GoDaddy, ...) he needs to fill out the WEBSITE – DOMAIN function with the domain name – and provide the MX records from his domain provider or contact support@deltagroup.com for assistance.

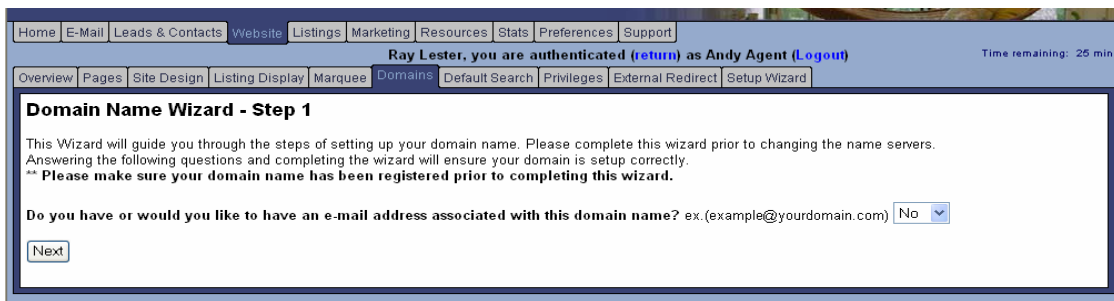
Note: If not using one of the above scenarios – please contact support@deltagroup.com for assistance

Scenario 3 : The following steps are needed if setting Domain Nameservers (DNS)

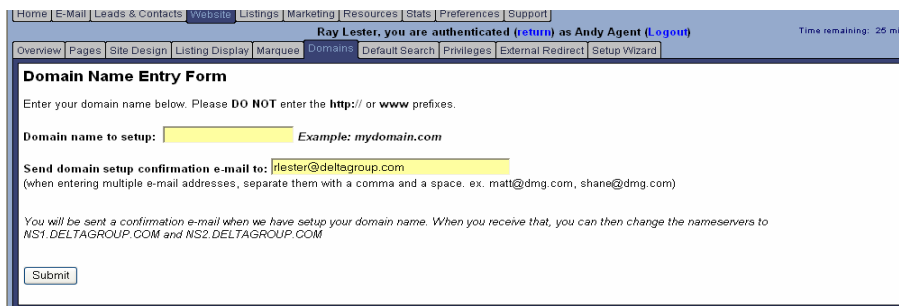
Use DeltaNet login into access your Control Panel and select WEBSITE - DOMAIN



Follow the Domain Name Wizard and select “NO” in Step 1.



Enter your Domain Name www.AndyAgent.com and an email for the confirmation.



You will receive a confirmation email and your site should be linked within 24-48 hours.

Scenario 4 & 5: The following steps are needed if setting Domain Nameservers (DNS) and email is associated with your domain.

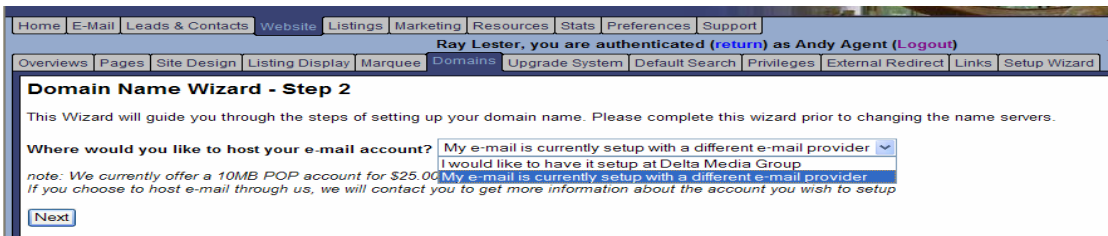
Use DeltaNet login into access your Control Panel and select WEBSITE - DOMAIN



Follow the Domain Name Wizard (if Andy wants to use Andy@AndyAgent.com as his email address) he would select "YES" in Step 1



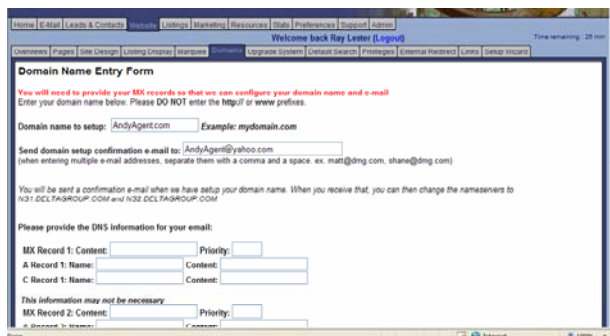
Select my email is setup with a different e-mail provider.



Enter your Domain Name www.AndyAgent.com and a confirmation email address AndyAgent@yahoo.com

Scenario 4: If your email is provided by a 3rd party – contact support@deltagroup.com to subscribe to email forwarding to forward email for example from Andy@AndyAgent.com to your AndyAgent@yahoo.com email account.

Scenario 5: If you email is provided by your domain provider – enter the MX records from your domain provider. For assistance contact support@deltagroup.com



You will receive a confirmation email and your site should be linked within 24-48 hours.
